JACK'S BASKET PURPOSE

Jack's Basket celebrates babies with Down syndrome. Our work begins from the time of diagnosis (prenatal or at-birth) to a baby's 1st birthday. We do this better than any other organization by focusing on three primary activities:

GROWTH STRATEGY

2022

BASKETS: 1,822 babies celebrated.*

HEALTHCARE: Created and launched the Prenatal Consult Film in partnership with our medical team. Continued to provide diagnosis advocacy training to healthcare providers across the country.

PROGRAM EXPANSION: Recruited 20 new parent volunteers, expanding our basket delivery and parent connection programs across the country.

FUNDRAISING: Raised more than \$1,000,000 to support the mission.

STAFF: Hired first Communications & Marketing Manager to help lead and expand outreach and awareness efforts.

2023

BASKETS: Celebrate 2,000+ babies.

HEALTHCARE: Develop DS Champion program, increase visibility to the medical community by presenting at medical conferences, and develop curriculum for communicating unexpected news.

PROGRAM EXPANSION: Recruit 25 new parent volunteers to fill roles as BDPs (Basket Delivery Parents) and RLPs (Regional Lead Parents) in areas of need.

FUNDRAISING: Expand corporate partnerships and raise more than \$1.1 million to support the mission.

STAFF: Onboard new Director of Programs and Development which brings staff to 6 employees.

3-5 YEAR PLAN

BASKETS: Celebrate 3,000+ babies annually.

HEALTHCARE: Leverage our experience as researchers to explore outcomes of Jack's Basket at the family and healthcare provider level.

PARTNERS: Expand partnerships from local/regional partners to national organizations and businesses.

FUNDRAISING: Increase fundraising every year to support the growing impact of Jack's Basket mission.

STAFF: Optimize full-time and part-time staff to continue to support our national programming.

*Each year in the United States, about 6,000 babies are born with Down syndrome, which is about 1 in every 700 babies born., *CDC*

2022 HIGHLIGHTS

GROWING

Our staff and volunteer teams experienced exciting growth this year to meet the needs of our expanding mission. We welcomed 20 new Basket Delivery and Regional Lead parent volunteers across the country. Now we have 68 BDPs serving 13 states and 15 RLPs leading in 9 states. In addition, we introduced a new staff position to manage our marketing and communication initiatives!



FUNDRAISING

With over 800 in-person guests and hundreds more attending virtually - we celebrated our 6th Annual 'You Make Me Better' Gala, raising over \$645,000 to celebrate the babies! Guests tuned in virtually from over 30 states and 9 countries. We are so amazed by and grateful for our community of donors who are committed to empowering this global movement to change the narrative around the Down syndrome diagnosis. EQUIPPING

In partnership with the Jack's Basket Medical Team, we launched The Prenatal Consult Film, our newest tool for prenatal providers.
